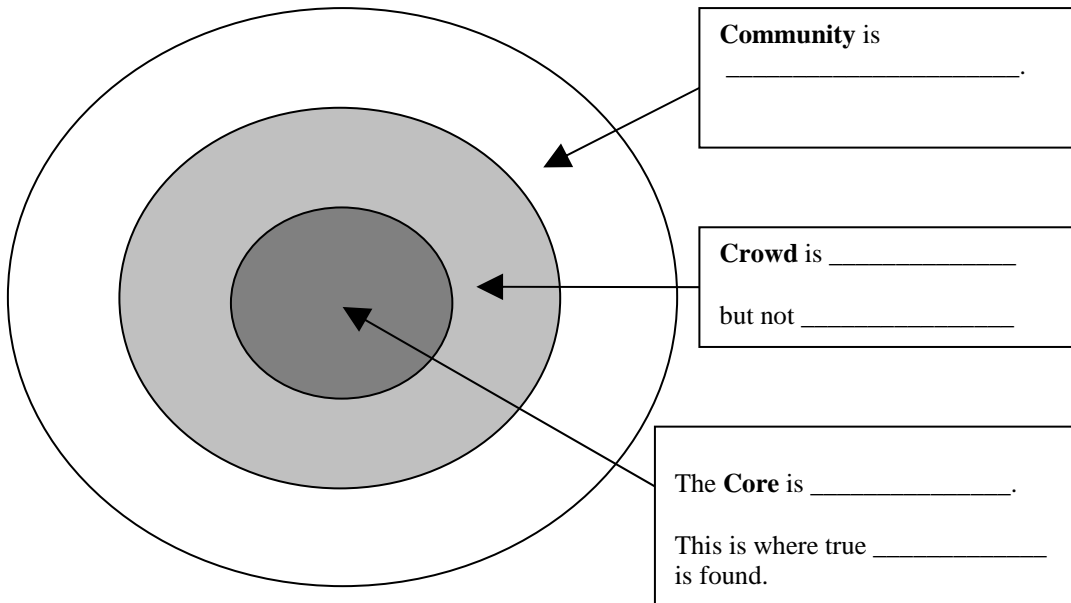
40 Days of Purpose – Part 3
